## AUDITORS' REPORT: To the Board of Bus Éireann - Irish Bus on the Operation of the School Transport Scheme

We have examined the annexed statement of account, which, together with the appendices to the statement, summarises the amount chargeable to the Department of Education for the year ended 31 December 2002 for the conveyance of primary and post-primary school children.

The net amount chargeable to the Department of Education amounts to €87,379,000 (2001: €71,345,000) and includes €10,001,000 (2001: €8,328,000) in respect of indirect and other direct costs calculated on the basis of 13% of direct costs. Direct costs for this purpose exclude amounts charged in respect of depreciation and interest on Bus Éireann - Irish Bus vehicles. In arriving at the amount chargeable for scheduled services, the factor for absenteeism has been taken into account at 4.5% in accordance with the Department of Education's letter dated 2 March 1970.

We have carried out such examinations and tests of the accounting and other records relating to the operation of the School Transport Scheme as we consider necessary for the purposes of our audit. The statement of account has been drawn up in accordance with the general arrangements and principles of accounting as set out in the Summary of Accounting Arrangements relating to the Transport Scheme for Primary and Post-Primary School Children dated 1 January 1975.

In our opinion the statement of account is a fair and reasonable statement of the amount chargeable to the Department of Education in respect of the School Transport Scheme.
